

Oto Logo is one of those contemporary Yugoslav sculptors whose work has become well known in art circles beyond the borders of his own country both by virtue of his frequent one-man or group exhibitions as well as by the acquisition of his individual works throughout numerous public and private collections in the art centres and capitals of Europe, Asia and America.

With this one-man show the Sculptor marks his twentieth year of active creative exploration and intensive involvement in public cultural life. For this exhibition we have selected from his works in limited Editions, mainly concentrating upon those Bronzes examples of which may be found in public collections. One such work was selected to illustrate the Hayward Gallery poster for their exhibition of Contemporary Yugoslav Sculpture and this work has been returned to Britain at our request.

This is the artist's eighteenth one-man exhibition and his first in Britain.
